Environmental Ethics

About the Course

In a world faced with climate change and environmental disasters, India needs professionals and policymakers who understand the complex and subtle ethical considerations involved in drafting policies that promote development while at the same time protecting the natural environment. This course helps students develop a coherent conceptual framework to guide thought and action in relation to the natural world. As part of this course, students learn to analyze social and economic policies from the perspective of their impact on the environment. Rather than engage in a superficial critique of these policies, the course helps students critically analyze the underlying ethical philosophies that these policies draw upon for their ethical justification. Students gain an in-depth understanding of some of these dominant ethical philosophies with the discernment to draw upon useful insights from each while also recognizing their respective limitations. The intention of the course is to help students become adept at drawing upon humanity's rich heritage of ethical thought in finding just, sustainable and unifying solutions to environmental challenges.

Who should join?

This course is ideally suited for students, professionals, policymakers, those engaged in the development field, civil servants, civil society practitioners and all those interested in the ethical thinking that goes into the drafting and application of environmental policies. It would appeal to all those who seek to understand the framework of ideas that have shaped our current world's relationship with nature and who wish to gain insights into how this relationship can be rebuilt on a sound and sustainable basis.


